

BY LAWS FOR THE GPHC STALLION SERVICE AUCTION & FUTURITY

The GPHC-SSA was organized to fulfill the needs of the growing Paint Horse population, not only in Georgia, but nationwide. The goal of the GPHC-SSA is not only to benefit the stallion owners, but the mare owners and exhibitors as well.

1. The GPHC-SSA will be an entity of the GPHC.
2. The GPHC-SSA will be organized and run by the GPHC board.
3. The GPHC-SSA Futurity will be run in conjunction with the GPHC Futurity and show.
4. The GPHC-SSA will pay out at least 70% of collected fees.
5. Classes Offered:
 - A. Senior Weanling Fillies (1/1 – 3/31)
 - B. Junior Weanling Fillies (4/1 – 12/31)
 - C. Senior Weanling Colts/Geldings (1/1 – 3/31)
 - D. Junior Weanling Colts/Geldings (4/1 – 12/31)
 - E. Yearling Halter Stallions
 - F. Yearling Halter Mares
 - G. Yearling Halter Geldings
 - H. Yearling Longe Line
 - I. Two Year Old Snaffle Bit Western Pleasure
 - J. Two & Three Year Old Hunter Under Saddle
6. Only horses with Regular & SPB Registration Papers from the APHA are eligible for the SSA Futurity.
7. All APHA registered get by the stallions whose services sold or were paid up will be eligible to show in the SSA Futurity, including longe line, 2 year olds and 3 year olds. If the stallion has not sold or been paid up, only people with free entries under that stallion may show.
8. If the stallion has not sold, the stallion owner may buy back the service from July 1st through September 1st at a cost of \$300.00. After September 1st and before October 15th, the buy back will be 60% of the advertised stud fee plus a \$150.00 fee. From October 15th until the day before the futurity the buy back cost will be the advertised stud fee plus a \$250.00 fee.
9. Any stallion that is paid up that year and dies or becomes unable to breed, the last foal crop is eligible to show through their 3 year old year.
10. APHA registered foals born in the same year as the stallion is nominated and sold, will be eligible to show in that year, including longe line, 2 year olds and 3 year olds. Example: If you nominate and sell your stallion in 1999, all APHA foals born in 1999 are eligible to show.
11. There will be no refunds on stallion service purchases.

SS AUCTION

1. The stallion service will be sold by silent auction at the GPHC Futurity, as announced. The bidding will start at 50% of the advertised fee at the time of the auction or \$300.00, which ever is greater. The minimum bid for any service will be \$300.00.
2. If the stallion does not stand to the public, or stands at private treaty with no advertised stud fee, the minimum bid will be established by the number of mares listed in the stallions last breeding report. Table: 0-5 mares = \$300.00, 6-10 mares = \$400.00, 11-15 mares = \$500.00, 16-20 mares = \$600.00, 21-25 mares = \$800.00, 26-30 mares = \$900.00, 31 + above mares = \$1000.00.
3. If your stallion book is closed, or does not stand to the public, you will be expected to pay up your stallion at the time of nomination.
4. When a stallion service is purchased through the SSA, the mare owner and stallion owner will each receive one free entry in the Futurity. This entry is good for one class only. It may be used in any class through the 3 year old year.
